Recycling at LCOS: In the past recycling bins could be found along the hallway between the kitchen and bathrooms. Due to more rigorous enforcement of Fire Safety regulations items may no longer be stored in this hallway to ensure a clear pathway to the emergency exit.

What goes where?

Items for the blue cart: Please place items destined for the blue cart into the paper/dry recycling bin found in the kitchen where the large garbage can once was. In addition, over the summer and into the fall additional recycling bins will be placed in classrooms throughout the building.

Organic/Green Cart: Please place organics in the organics bin clearly marked near the coffee maker. At this time the organics will be going in the black bin until the green cart recycling arrives in the fall for our community.

Regular Garbage/Black Cart: A small bin beside the organic bin can be found in the kitchen near the coffee maker. In addition garbage cans are found throughout the building.

Pop bottles: We have temporarily placed a large garbage can by the mailboxes to collect pop bottles etc. that are generated within the church. We are looking for a more suitable permanent location and will announce it when complete. Please do not bring your pop bottles from home at this time. We do not have the space to store them.

Kitchen Cabinet: We have re-used all but one small cabinet within the building that was removed for the installation of the new appliances. Please help yourself to the cabinet if you have a use for it.
