The focus of each gathering is to explore what makes us wonder, what surprises or annoys us from the text and sharing it with the group. Everyone is welcome.

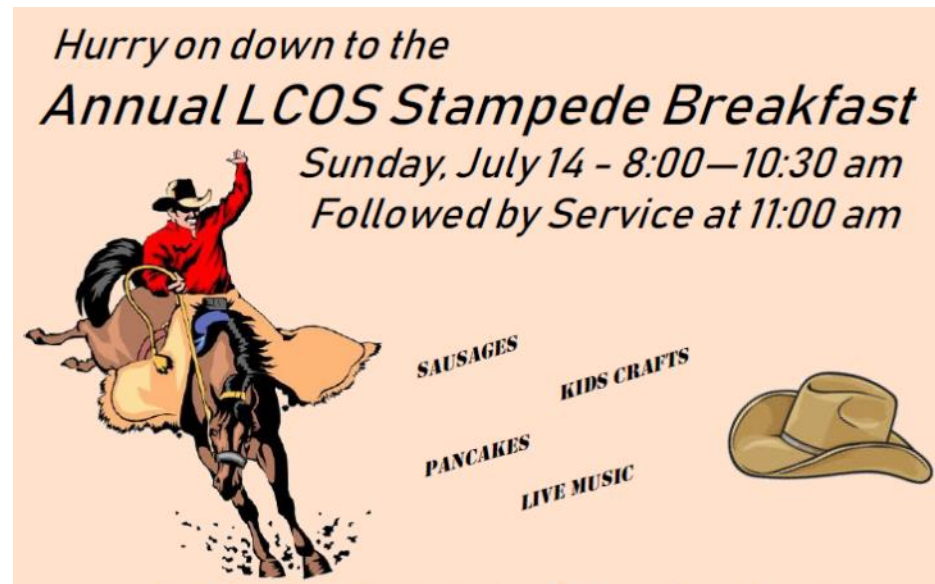
Sunday June 9 at 11:30 am - Youth Band Practice
