If you were unable to submit a pledge on Stewardship Sunday there is still time. Please see an usher for a pledge card that you can complete and place in the offering plate.



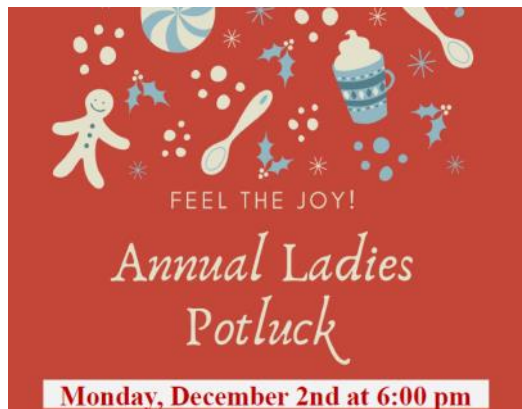

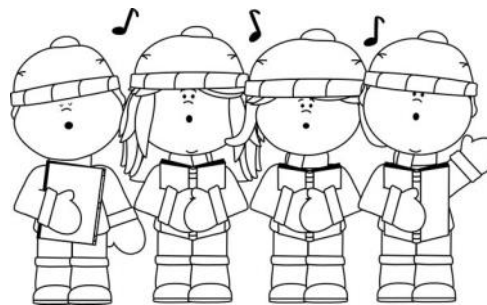

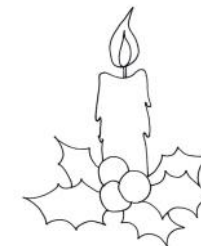
