There is a need to update the contact and membership information in the church database. Please look for an envelope with your name set out with the Offering Envelopes. Any corrections will be entered so that our records are current.

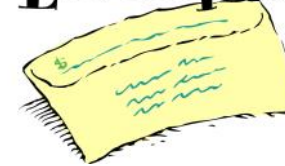
**Prayer List:** As we begin another blessed new year, we will be re-starting the Prayer List. If you wish to have us continue to pray for someone currently listed, please contact the office.
